Withdrawal Policy

Three-Day Cancellation: An applicant who provides written notice of cancellation within three days (excluding Saturday, Sunday and federal and state holidays) of signing an enrollment agreement is entitled to a refund of all money paid except application fee.

Before commencement of classes / 2 days of classes: An applicant requesting cancellation more than three days after signing an enrollment agreement and making an initial payment, but prior to entering the training course or within **two days** of starting training, is entitled to a refund of all monies paid, less application fee and enrollment deposit.

After the commencement of classes: Tuition refund (minus amount application fee and deposit) shall be determined as follows:

Requested 3 days after training begins and before Nov 1, 2020	If paid in full, refund will be made after deducting application fees, enrollment deposit and 1st installment.
Requested Nov 1, 2020 or later:	No refund will be made. Full tuition is due.
